Nationally known bird handler Ken Globus "The Bird Whisperer" will conduct a dynamic, comprehensive, four-hour group session (workshop). He will also illustrate how birds respond to subtle movements and touches and demonstrate how to make huge strides in a minimum of time. Directions to the Pottstown Holiday Inn Express

From Harrisburg area

Follow the PA Turnpike East to Exit 22. Follow Route I-176 North about 10 miles to Route 422. Follow Route 422 East to Pottstown and take the Armand Hammer Blvd Exit. Make a left at the end of the ramp followed by a left into the Holiday Inn Express parking lot.

From Washington, DC area

Follow Route 270 North to Frederick, MD area where Route 270 turns into Route 15. Follow Route 15 North and take the PA Turnpike East to Exit 22. Follow Route I-176 North about 10 miles to Route 422. Follow Route 422 East to Pottstown and take the Armand Hammer Blvd Exit. Make a left at the end of the ramp followed by a left into the Holiday Inn Express parking lot.

From Scranton Wilkes-Barre area

Follow I-81 South to Route 61 (Exit 36). Follow Route 61 South to Route 222 South. Follow Route 222 South to Route 422 East. Follow Route 422 East and take the Armand Hammer Blvd Exit. Make a left at the end of the ramp followed by a left into the Holiday Inn Express parking lot.

From York area

Follow Route 30 East to Route 222 North to the PA Turnpike East. Follow the PA Turnpike East to Exit 22. Follow Route I-176 North about 10 miles to Route 422. Follow Route 422 East to Pottstown and take the Armand Hammer Blvd Exit. Make a left at the end of the ramp followed by a left into the Holiday Inn Express parking lot.

From Lancaster area

Follow Route 222 North to the PA Turnpike East. Follow the PA Turnpike East to Exit 22. Follow Route I-176 North about 10 miles to Route 422. Follow Route 422 East to Pottstown and take the Armand Hammer Blvd Exit. Make a left at the end of the ramp followed by a left into the Holiday Inn Express parking lot.

From Allentown area

Follow Route 29 South to Route 100 South to Route 422 East. Follow Route 422 East and take the Armand Hammer Blvd Exit. Make a left at the end of the ramp followed by a left into the Holiday Inn Express parking lot.

From Baltimore, MD area

Follow I-95 North to I-476 (Exit 7). Follow I-476 North to I-76 (Exit 6B). Follow I-76 West about 4 miles then follow directions from Philadelphia / Valley Forge area.

From Philadelphia / Valley Forge area

From I-76 take Route 202 South a short distance to Route 422. Follow Route 422 West about 19 miles to and take the Armand Hammer Blvd Exit. Keep left at the fork in the ramp and then go straight through the intersection onto Industrial Highway. Follow Industrial Highway a short distance to the Holiday Inn Express on the left.

From West Chester area

Follow Route 100 North to Route 422. Follow Route 422 East and take the Armand Hammer Blvd Exit. Make a left at the end of the ramp followed by a left into the Holiday Inn Express parking lot.
